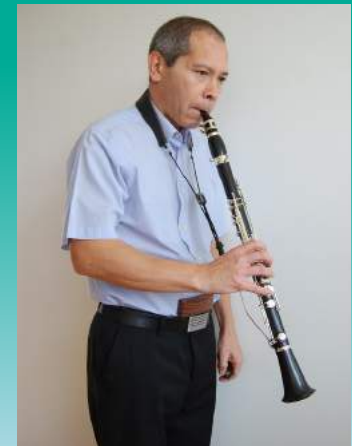
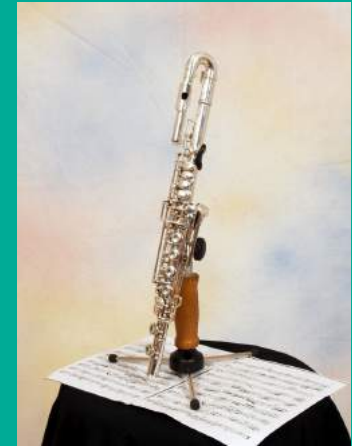

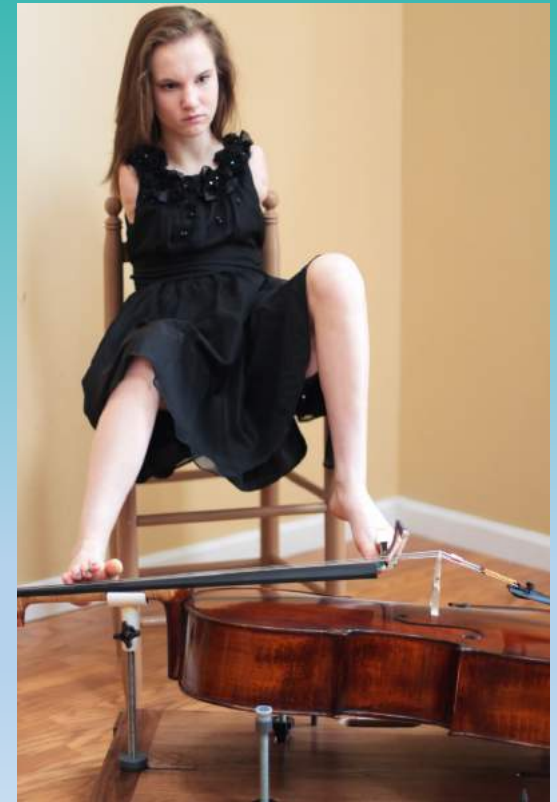


Turkish Oud
